Automated email alerts let constituents know if documents are recorded using

their information.



Constituents can keep an eye on specific properties of interest.



Alerts are free but access to images requires a paid subscription with the county.


The Document Alert feature in Document Pro™ makes it easy for your recording office to keep constituents informed of when documents are recorded using their information. The solution generates and sends automated email alerts detailing the recordings, which can then be used by your constituents to determine whether acts of fraud have been committed or if the recordings are valid. In addition to protecting against identity theft and fraud, Document Alert simply gives constituents a way to follow activity related to properties of interest.

Constituents can sign up for and manage their alerts within iDoc Market — Document Pro's citizen self-service solution. Having the iDoc Market solution in place in your county is required before you can take advantage of Document Alert. An additional license for the Document Alert feature is also required.

KFY FFATURES

- Recordings are verified on a nightly basis, triggering the creation of automated email alerts detailing potential fraud situations.
- The alerts are offered at no charge to constituents, increasing transparency and goodwill within your county.
- Email alerts can be configured based on name or parcel number within a constituent's iDoc Market account.

- Constituents have the ability to view indexed information for the recorded document in question, or an image of the actual document if they have a paid subscription with the county, by clicking the hyperlink within their automated email alert.
- Tyler handles the collection of any subscription fees and reimburses your office.
- Automated alerts can be set up across multiple jurisdictions, as long as those jurisdictions utilize iDoc Market.
- Detailed alert history located within iDoc Market allows constituents to look at previous alerts and use hyperlinks to view images of the recorded documents.
